Good afternoon Grizzly Parents,

It's hard to believe that the end of the school year is quickly approaching. I want to communicate a few important things to help the school year finish strong.

1. Next week, Monday May 20th we will start finals in all our classes. The final exam schedule will be posted on the website. During final exams we will not pull students to be released to leave school. To protect the testing environment, once the period begins students must remain the entire period.
2. Final Exams will not be given early. Students need to be here to take their finals. If they miss the final exam they will receive a zero. If you have any questions about final exams, please contact Ms. Papaioannou, the Director of Instruction.
3. The cell phone policy is still in effect. Student's cell phones need to be turned off and out of sight during the school day unless they have been directed to use them by the teacher for academic purposes. Violation of the policy will result in the phone being picked up and a parent or guardian will have to come and retrieve the phone and pay a \$15 administration fee.
4. Only legal parents or guardians can sign a student out of school. If you know you will be picking up a student early, please send a letter with your student to school so we can expedite the checkout process. If you are going to have another family member picking up your student, you must send a note with your child and we will call to verify the individual has permission to pick up the student.
5. High School and College students will not be allowed on campus during regular school hours.
6. Car Riders: We are seeing students walk out to Huffmeister and Baker Cypress to get into a car. This is both dangerous and illegal. All riders must be dropped off and picked up in the designed car rider location in the front of the building. Both CFPD and Harris County have asked that I inform parents that if they fail to comply they may be issued a citation.
